Dear Friends

It has been really good to be back in church since Palm Sunday and it was fine to have a full church on Easter Day! (By full, I mean the 50 people we are allowed to accommodate).

It's also very encouraging to see Lockdown restrictions gradually being eased and to know that so many people have had their first and, in many cases, second vaccine.

The Scottish Government has announced that limits on attendance at worship and also at weddings and funerals will be increased over the new few weeks. By the end of June, it is to be 200! However, because the 2m physical distancing rule will remain in place this will not in fact make any difference to us as the maximum we can accommodate with these restrictions is still 50. It is clearly still going to be quite some time before we will see any return to normality in worship. The day that we can stand up and sing again will be a very happy one!

I continue to miss visiting people in their homes, popping into the hospital and Care Homes and visiting the school. I spend far too much time in front of a computer screen. But hopefully it will be possible to resume this later in the year, but you can never be sure!

There will be one more Newsletter in June and then hopefully we can return to our normal church magazine in the autumn.

Finally, thank you to all the volunteers who have sought to ensure that the work of the congregation continues. Donald Muir has taken on extra work in the absence of a church secretary just now, while Fiona Jones has kindly taken on the bookings for services. Val Muir has organised the streaming of our services on Facebook, which many appreciate. And Colin Jones continues to do a fantastic job on the technology side of things, by editing video school assemblies for me, as well as undertaking the production of the Aberdeen West services for a period recently. Thank you to everyone, including those whom I've probably missed out!


