## **Ordination and Induction at Aberdeen North**

Presbytery met on 2nd March for the ordination and induction of Mrs Fiona Lister to the charge of Aberdeen North which had been formed by the union of Northfield, Mastrick and Summerhill parishes with the former Mastrick Church being the building retained.

Fiona was highly regarded when she did part of her training here at Peterculter with John Ferguson from October 2019 to May 2020.

#### Union of High Hilton and Woodside

At the February meeting, Presbytery approved the Basis of Union agreed between the congregations of Woodside and High Hilton which was in accordance with the Presbytery Plan. The name of the new charge will be Aberdeen Hillside Parish Church of Scotland with the High Hilton building being retained and the Woodside building being disposed of. Aberdeen Hillside will form part of a grouping with Aberdeen North.


