FROM THE SESSION CLERK

We have now been in vacancy for a full six months and it is heartening to see most church activities continuing as normal and our Sunday morning worship attendances holding up well. This is a credit to the dedicated volunteers who give of their time to enable this and excellence of the ministers who have kindly agreed to lead our services each week and our thanks is extended to each of them.

I'm delighted to confirm that the Rev. Mark Rodgers will be providing two days a week support as Locum during the months of July, September and November. This will allow a more proactive approach to pastoral care to be taken which will be welcomed by many, particularly the housebound. Mark recently retired from his position as Lead Chaplain and Head of Spiritual Care within NHS Grampian Hospital Chaplaincy and has already helped us greatly by providing regular pulpit supply.

We still await a decision from the new Presbytery of the North East and Northern Isles on whether a full time minister can be appointed to join the Aberdeen West ministry team to replace the Rev. Dr. John Ferguson. There are several complicating factors preventing any prompt decision being made, not least the necessary but as yet undecided changes to local parish boundaries brought about by some churches closing and the influence that then has upon the allocation of ministry positions.

Therefore it is particularly helpful to have secured the services of Mark as part-time Locum during the second half of this year. The ministers in the Aberdeen West Parish Grouping will continue to provide any necessary pastoral support during the periods when he is not available.
