At the Presbytery meeting on the 6th of February Presbyters were urged to promote "Run for

"CrossReach" at "Run Balmoral" on Saturday 27th of April, encouraging congregation members to take part and raise funds for local CrossReach facilities. Within the bounds of Presbytery CrossReach, the Social Care Arm of the Church of Scotland, runs 6 Centres/Projects, 2 in Stonehaven and 1 in each of Balmedie, Banchory, Buckie and the Shetland Isles.
