PRESBYTERY MATTERS

At the Presbytery meeting on Tuesday the 23rd of April the following were included:

Moderator Designate

Presbytery appointed the Rev Shuna Dicks (Cults Parish Church) to succeed the Rev Stella Campbell (Kingshill Parish Church, Westhill) as Presbytery Moderator for a two year period following her induction at the June meeting. This is a demanding role alongside being a Parish Minister.

Kirk of St Nicholas

The General Trustees have authorised the transfer of Kirk of St Nicholas to Edinburgh Palette, an Arts charity, and also authorised a "dowry" of £400k to accompany the transfer of the building.

Fraserburgh and District Parish Church

At this time of change within the Church of Scotland, the churches in Fraserburgh show the extent to which change is happening. Presbytery approved a union of seven churches with three church buildings to be retained for worship and four to be sold, let or otherwise disposed of. The name of the united charge is to be Fraserburgh and District Parish Church of Scotland. Two Ministers of Word and Sacrament are to be appointed to Team Ministry with a Renewable Tenure of five years with Presbytery to review the union after five years. The review will look at how successful the union has been to see, amongst other measures, whether the life of the congregation exhibits the five purposes of the church, i.e. worship, service, discipleship, fellowship and evangelism.
