FROM THE SESSION CLERK

At the end of October 2022, Peterculter Church became vacant when Rev. Dr. John Ferguson left to become Presbytery Clerk for the new Presbytery of Perth. Drumoak-Durris Church became vacant shortly afterwards in April 2023 when Rev. Jean Boyd retired. The Presbytery plan allocated 0.5 of a full time post to each Church, meaning that neither Church on their own was able to call a new minister.

Following the union of the two Churches on 1st November 2023 to form the new Peterculter Parish Church, permission was granted by Presbytery to call a minister for the new charge. A Nominating Committee was elected in February 2024 and, after much diligent searching, has proposed that Rev. Emma McDonald be our new minister. The Rev. McDonald is currently a pioneer minister with the Church of Scotland in Dundee but has had previous parish ministry experience and is keen to get back to being a parish minister.

Arrangements have been made for the Rev. McDonald to conduct public worship at Peterculter Church on **Sunday 27th April 2025 at 10.30 am**. After this service a vote will be taken by the congregation on whether Rev. McDonald should be inducted as the minister of Peterculter Parish Church.

This is an exciting time in the life of our Church and I'm sure everyone is keen to play their part. The next steps will of course depend on the result of the vote. We will endeavour to share any news with the congregation as soon as we are able to do so.




